FAST TRACK SUMMER TUITION WAIVER

The Fast Track Tuition Waiver is available during NPC's summer session to graduating high school students that will be graduating from a local high school within Navajo and Apache county. The Fast Track Summer Tuition Wavier only covers the cost of tuition. The tuition waiver will cover a maximum of 12 credits.

Eligibility Criteria:

- Must be a high school graduate within the same academic year prior to summer session.
- Must be a high school graduate from a high school within Navajo or Apache county.
- Must provide a social security number for scholarship to be applied to student's billing account.
- Cost of the media fee and any course fees must be paid at the time of registration.
- Cost of required textbooks and digital materials are the student's responsibility to order and pay.
- Must submit form by June 28th 4:00 PM deadline. Form submitted after the deadline will be denied.

Three simple steps to apply:

- 1) Student completes the Student Information section.
- 2) Student presents form to High School Counselor to complete the High School Counselor Information.
- 3) High school counselor returns form to student to use when registering for summer course(s).
