

Juried Student Art Show 2021

The purpose of the NPC Student Art Show is to showcase student accomplishments in the visual arts and honor exceptional achievement. All NPC students are encouraged to participate.

The NPC Student Art Show is a juried exhibition. A panel of jurors will review all of the submitted artworks and select the pieces that will appear in the show. Not all submitted works will be exhibited. Acceptance to a show that has been juried is an honor. It is a distinction that can be listed on a resume and is the type of professional recognition that is essential to any student pursuing a career in art. The jury puts much consideration into the selection process. Successful composition, craftsmanship, mastery of medium, and originality are all evaluated. Students should be aware that the jury process is intended to encourage artistic growth. Any questions about jurying may be addressed to the art faculty:

Entry Rules:

• Due to Covid-19 restrictions, the Talon Gallery is not open to the public during the Spring 2021 semester. Because of this, the NPC Juried Student Art Show will be hosted online on the gallery website (www.npc.edu/talongallery).

• Any NPC Student enrolled in either Fall 2020 or Spring 2021 semesters may enter artwork in the Juried NPC Student Art Show. Student need not be enrolled in an art class. Artworks of any material are eligible (including but not limited to: painting, sculpture, photography, fiber arts, jewelry, metal work, woodwork....etc).

• All work must be original. No reproductions of copyrighted material will be accepted. Entries must not have previously been shown in the Talon Gallery.

• Entries and entry form must be submitted digitally. The images that are submitted of your artwork will be the images that are juried, and, if selected, displayed in the online exhibition. It is essential that you provide high quality images of your artwork. Please contact your instructor for assistance with photographing your artwork. • You must complete an entry form with information for each artwork. Artwork submitted without an entry form will not be included in the exhibition.
