Late applications will be considered on a space available basis if they meet the admission criteria, but will not be accepted before applications submitted on time.

If you have never been an NPC student, please begin by completing a college enrollment application to obtain a Student ID# prior to submitting a bachelor's degree program application. You may apply by going to your nearest campus or center or online at: <https://www.npc.edu/Application>.

Include this checklist as the first page of your application packet.

Submit the following items:

- Completed, signed application (including student information, program requirements page, and signature page)
- If an NPC graduate**, a copy of your transcripts showing your awarded Associate degree (or higher).
- If a non-NPC graduate**, a copy of your **official** transcripts showing your awarded degree.
- Proof of FAFSA application submission for the academic year of admittance (even if not eligible for financial aid).
- A copy of your current Arizona DPS Level 1, **Identity Verified Prints (IVP)** Card (front *and* back). Apply at: <https://psp.azdps.gov/>. **Plan ahead** as the process requires *at least 6-8 weeks* or more. (If your application is still being processed, enclose a copy of your receipt.) If you need instructions on how to obtain a fingerprint card, contact the Educator Preparation Programs Department (928-524-7336 or dora.jaquez@npc.edu).
- A 2-3 page, typed (12pt font), double-spaced "personal essay." The essay should address the following:
 - What is your philosophy of education, and specifically why is early childhood important for children and communities?
 - why you wish to attend the BAS program at NPC;
 - a description of your professional/career and educational goals;

- what you have done to date to meet your goals;
- an explanation of your commitment to maintaining enrollment and completing the program in two years; and
- what value you bring to NPC's bachelor's degree program.

You are responsible to make sure that all of the required documents are received in the Educator Preparation Programs Department office *on time*. If *any item* is missing from the application at the time applications are due, your entire application will be considered late.
